

## Supplies

<u>Grateful Heart Stamp and Die Set</u> <u>Book Engravings Stamp and Die Set</u> 36 Pan Watercolor Set

4 ½ x 5 ½ Patterned Paper for background

 $2 \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$  Embossed Paper Coordinates that coordinates with background

Watercolor Paper

 $4\frac{1}{4} \times \frac{1}{2}$  Side Folding Card Base

<u>Crisp Dye Inks-</u> Orange Leaf and Frayed Leaf

 $\frac{3}{4} \times 17/8$  Sentiment Strip

Mixed Media Ink

## Directions:

- 1. Stamp your flower and leaves on the watercolor paper. I used Crisp Dye Inks in the same color as my flowers and leaves. Orange Cream and Frayed Leaf. Allow to dry completely before applying watercolor to keep the outline. You can even use a heat tool to set the ink.
- 2. Once your images are completely dry, die cut the flower and leaves and set aside.
- 3. Emboss your coordinating paper. For this piece I used the same color dye ink in Frayed Leaf to color in the leaves on this embossing.
- 4. Adhere your  $4\frac{1}{4} \times 5\frac{1}{2}$  patterned paper to the card base.
- 5. Adhere your flower to the  $2 \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$  embossed piece with liquid glues only where it is on the embossed piece.
- $6.\ Use\ foam\ square/tape\ to\ adhere\ the\ whole\ thing\ to\ your\ card\ base.$
- 7. Add your sentiment with foam squares/tape. I used Mixed Media Ink to emboss my sentiment.
- 8. Don't forget to share or send your creation!
