Supplies

PAF Tulips (Altenew Dec Release)
36 Pan Watercolor Set
Sentiment Strips
Obsidian Black Pigment Ink
Clear Embossing Powder
Gingham Checked Patterned Paper
Grosgrain Ribbon
Butterfly Punch/Die
Self-Adhesive Gemstones
Adhesive Tape Runner or Liquid Glue

Directions:

- 1. Begin with a standard A2 size piece of watercolor paper.
- 2. Stamp the image using black pigment ink and clear embossing powder.

(don't forget to "prep" the surface with anti-static powder first)

3. Saturate your brush with the darkest hue of color and begin painting at the base of the tulips.

As you use your paint on your brush add a little water and "drag" the color to the tip of each petal. Add your color using as little water as you can. This is how I got the almost velvet look on these tulips. I used additional colors for the smaller flowers.

- 4. While your card front is drying, apply the patterned paper to the card base, and stamp your sentiment.
- 5. Cut your card front down to the size needed to show off your background a little bit.
- 6. Apply the ribbon and sentiment to the card front before adhering it to the card base.
