Watercolor Wednesday With Rachael



Supplies

PAF- Daffodils
36 Pan Watercolor Set
Water color paper $4 \times 5 \frac{1}{4}$ Stamp positioning tool (Misti) $4 \frac{1}{4} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ top fold card base
Corner Rounder
Distress Ink-Antique Linen
Patterned Paper
Obsidian Black Ink
Sequins

Directions:

This is a pretty straightforward watercolor card with the biggest difference being I used the Distress Ink for my outline. This allowed me to create a less obvious "stamped" image, and still maintain the outline of the image.

- 1) I first stamped my floral images using my stamp positioning tool on opposite corners of the watercolor paper with the Distress Ink-Antique Linen
- 2) I then colored in my images using the 36 Pan Watercolor Set
- 3) While allowing the card front to dry completely, I adhered my patterned paper to my 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ card base in the top fold position.
- 4) Once dried, I stamped my sentiment in the center of the card front, again using the stamp positioning tool.
- 5) I then used the corner rounder punch to round the corners and added my sequins.
- 6) Lastly, I used foam tape to add the card front to my card base.
