

Wednesday Watercolors with Book Engravings Stamp and Die Bundle



Supplies

Book Engravings Stamp and Die Set
Shutter Cover Die
36 Pan Watercolor Set and brushes
Ultra-Marine Crisp Dye Inks
Sentiment Strip Stamp Set
(2) 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ pieces of cardstock
4 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ Top Folding Card Base
watercolor paper
black cardstock
white cardstock
Ink Blending Tool
Adhesives
Foam Tape

Directions

Begin by die cutting the Shutter Cover Die from sturdy cardstock. (80# used here)
Stamp the images you are using onto water color paper. (I used Distress Ink in Pumice Stone)

I begin my water coloring with a complete overall color of the images. Once completely dried, I go back in with a more concentrated saturation on my brush and color in the darker areas I want to highlight. The lines on the leaves and flowers as well as some areas in the petals.

While waiting for my images to dry, I use the Shutter cover die as a stencil and completely color in my background using the Ultra Marine Crisp Dye Ink. I achieve this by using a removeable adhesive on the back of the cardstock to keep the stencil in place.

I create my sentiment by stamping them out onto a piece of white cardstock, and adhering to the black background cut to size.

Once everything is dry, I cut out my images and assemble my card.
