Supplies

Cherished Memories Stamp and Die Bundle
Shutter Cover Die Set
4 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ Side Fold Card Base
4 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ white card stock
Re-Inkers-Used for Watercoloring
Frayed Leaf and Forest Glades
Fresh Lemon and Maple Yellow
Crisp Dye Ink for Blending-
Dew Drops Crisp Dye In
Ink Blending tool
Foam Adhesive and Liquid Glue

Directions

*My technique for using re-inkers as watercolors is to place a couple of drops onto my Teflon work surface and add a bit of water until I get the level of color I am looking for. I have a scrap of paper handy to test the color before applying to my image. It is very important to use watercolor paper.

- 1) Stamp the images from the Cherished Memories stamp set with a watercolor safe ink, choose the color you want use, paint and set aside to dry.
- 2) Using the ink blending tool, blend the Dew Drops Crisp Dye Ink onto your card base.
- 3) Cut the Shutter Cover Die from a piece of white card stock for your background and adhere with liquid glue to the ink blended card base.
- 4) Die cut your dry stamped and colored images and arrange them onto the center of your card with foam adhesive.
- 5) Add the sentiment of your choice with foam tape.
